Aims and Hypothesis (up to 10 pts)
Methodology and Approach (up to 15 pts)
Presentation of results and statistical analyses (up to 20 pts)
Conclusions (up to 10 pts)
Novelty & significance (up to 5 pts)
Biography and track record (relative to opportunity) (40 pts)
Career Goals (up to 20 pts)
Publications (papers, abstracts, or other forms of public scientific data presentation) (up to 10 pts)
Track Record (incl. Honors, Distinctions & Awards) (up to 10 pts)
